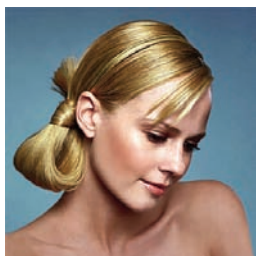

If you plan to visit the tanning bed prior to the wedding,

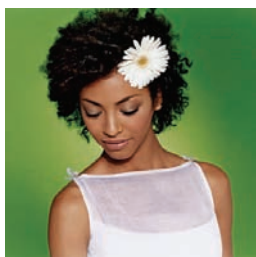
we advise tanning bed clients to take advantage of the heat by running a deep conditioner through hair before wrapping it up.
